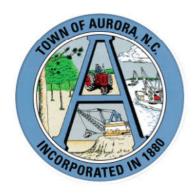

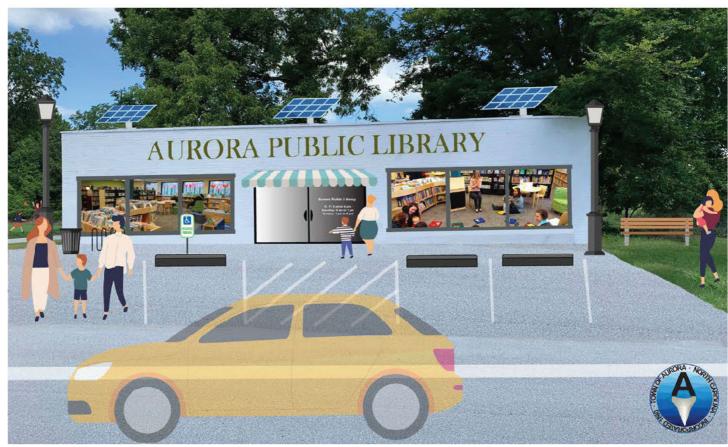
#### **AURORA PUBLIC LIBRARY**

The waterfront should be celebrated. Widening the existing sidewalk and creating a multi-use trail makes this peninsula of land a more welcoming place for different modes of transportation and has the potential of making it a destination.

Pedestrian-scale lighting prevents any hindrance of the natural view from the existing light poles. A part of the NC Greenway connects down through NC-306 and turns right to continue to NC-306, away from Aurora, but incorporating sharrows on Main Street could entice bicyclists to take a scenic break through Aurora and at its waterfront.
